NBA now follows the Outcome Based Education (OBE) model for accreditation of programmes offered by institutions. Once a program is accredited, it will have global acceptability and promotes students mobility along with enhancement in employability. Consequent upon this trend, the debate on how benchmarks have to be evolved for ascertaining and assuring quality at different levels of higher education is significant. **NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council)** initiates to promote the concept of best practices benchmarking.

It also set the stages of identification, dissemination, sustenance and adaptation of best practices and of their transference from one system to the other. Benefits of accreditation for institutions include ease of funding from various bodies, change of perceptions among all stakeholders, improvement of student enrollment both in terms of quality and quantity.
