4. Academic Excellence:

4.1 Academic Curriculum Planning through Teaching Plan.

Every faculty member of all programs plans their teaching activity by preparing a teaching plan for their allotted course and enriches the teaching by putting 12.5% contents which is beyond syllabus.

4.2 Continuous Evaluation and Feedback.

Continuous assessment of students throughout the semester and year has been monitored through the following processes.

- 4.2.1 Internal sessional examination: Three sessional exams conducted per semester by each department. First sessional exam having syllabus of first & second unit, second sessional having syllabus of third and fourth unit and third sessional exam is having syllabus of fifth and sixth unit. - 4.2.2 Course coverage of the teaching faculty members is continuously monitored by Head of the department after every fifteen days, if any deficiency is found then strict action is taken against the concern faculty. For the academic session **2014-15** no such actionable things has been reported by HOD.
- 4.2.3 Student feedback system: -Feedback of teaching faculty has been taken twice per semester by each department to know about the performance of teaching faculty member. For the academic session **2014-15**, after the analysis of all feedback forms given by the students , it's found that **10 faculty** members is having unsatisfactory performance out of **168 faculty members** and concern action is taken by the head of the department to take corrective measures so that the feedback of faculty is improved and the students are satisfied.

4.3 Teacher Guardian and Teacher-on-Demand Schemes

- 4.3.1 Teacher Guardian Scheme: - Strong teacher guardian scheme through which student share their problems and thoughts regarding academics, personal problems etc. with the concern teacher guardian. Through this processes we filter out the strong and weak students and solve their problems by means of taking extra classes, extra tests etc. students who fail or do not perform well in the internal tests / model tests, were consulted individually and the information about the same is conveyed to the parents through personal contact over phone or by performance letter through post. Parents are requested and encouraged to visit the college and meet the HODs to discuss their ward's performance. For the academic session **2014-15** it's found that Teacher Guardian Schemes is executed in a proper manner by each and every teacher guardian.

- 4.3.2 Teacher-on-Demand Scheme: Teacher-on-demand scheme is executed per semester by each department, in this processes teaching faculty member get nominated for the different subject as per there interest, and then student gives the 3 staff preferences and on the basis of those preferences the subject is allotted to the teaching faculty member.
