

All the students are hereby informed to note that ragging is a cognizable offence and any student found involved in ragging is liable for punishment under Maharashtra Govt. ragging act. As per the notification of A.I.C.T.E , New Delhi dated 25/03/2009 if the incident of ragging take place within college campus or outside the campus then the institutional authorities would file a First Information Report (F.I.R) against ragging takers with the local police authorities and ragers will be debarred from taking admission in any technical institution in India .Also note that depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution , the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following.

01. Cancellation of admission.
02. Suspension from attending classes.
03. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
04. Debaring from appearing in any test /examination or other evaluation process.
05. Withholding results.
06. Debaring from representing the institution in any regional , national ,international meet, tournament ,youth festival, etc.
07. Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
08. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters.
09. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debaring from admission to any other institution.
10. Fine of Rs.25,000/-
11. Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to community pressure on the potential ragers.
